Biographical History

Established in February 1987 with headquarters in Kingman, AZ, the Historic Route 66 Association of Arizona consists of Route 66 enthusiasts representing at least dozen Arizona communities located along historic Route 66 between Topock and Lupton, AZ. Since its inception, the non-profit, all-volunteer Association's mission has been to preserve, protect and promote historic Route 66 which traverses Arizona from east to west for 200 miles.

Scope and Content Note

The collection encompasses five miscellaneous promotional printed items (i.e., multi-panel March 1988 Route 66 map, undated color photo postcard, undated information brochure and two flyers dated 1989 and 1991) produced by the Historic Route 66 Association of Arizona as well as 33 issues of its newsletter published monthly or



bimonthly from March 1988 through April 1992 (except missing issues – June 1988, August 1988, June 1989, August 1989, October through December 1989, April 1990 and August 1991 through December 1991).
